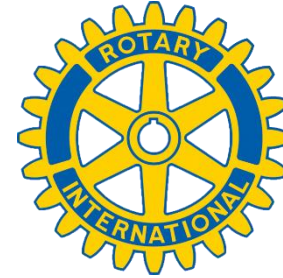

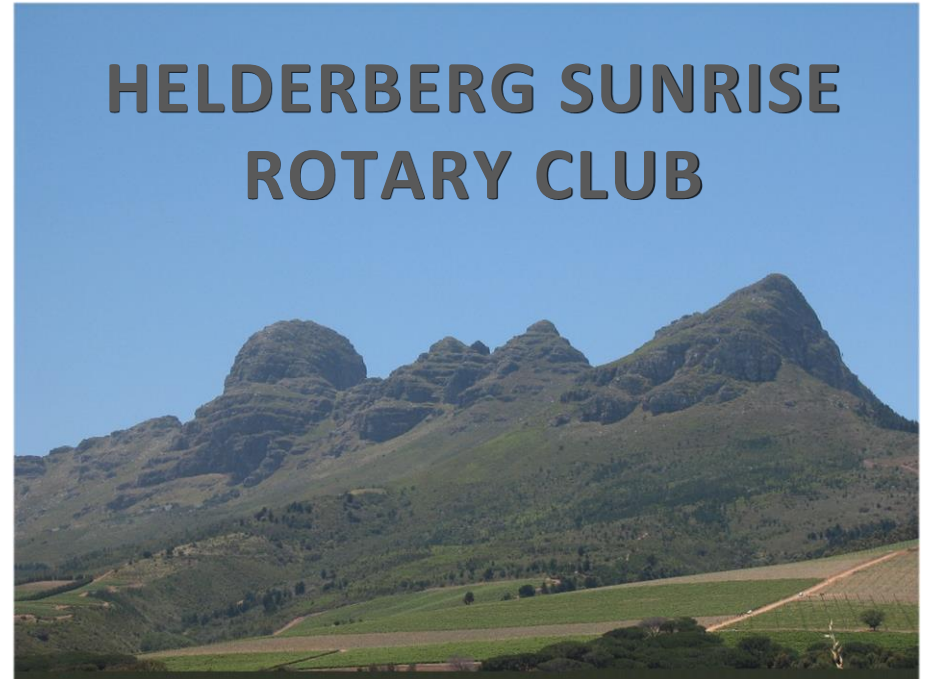

WHAT IS ROTARY?

Rotary International, the world's oldest service club organization, is made up of over 36 000 clubs in more than 200 countries and geographical areas. Its members comprise a network of business and professional leaders, who volunteer their time and talents to serve their communities, and promote international understanding, peace and goodwill.

Rotary's motto "**SERVICE ABOVE SELF**" exemplifies the humanitarian spirit and enthusiasm of the organisation's more than 1,2 million members. Strong fellowship and meaningful service projects in the community helping those in need is the hallmark of Rotary worldwide, and has been the underlying reason for Rotary's success and development since its formation in 1905.

WHO ARE WE?

The Helderberg Sunrise Rotary Club was founded in June 2006, with the specific mission to attract as members business and professional men and women from the greater Helderberg Basin, who want to serve society and enjoy good fellowship. We meet for breakfast every Tuesday morning early, so as to allow members to leave for their workplace by no later than 8am. Although we are a new Rotary Club, our members already have a proud record of service activities in the community. The club currently has 62 members from all walks of life, who have formed a really good bond of friendship and willingness to help those in need.

WHAT IS OUR MISSION?

Firstly, is to ensure that good fellowship exists amongst our members; that we have well organized weekly meetings with speakers on a variety of interesting subjects, and that we strive at all times to invite other business and professional people from the community to join us in our main objective of doing something for the needy in the Helderberg Basin.

CURRENT & RECENT PROJECTS / EVENTS



Give substantial financial support to **The Rotary Foundation** to help fund its many humanitarian, health and educational programs worldwide.



Khomani San - A project to improve the lives of the San people, preserve their culture, support education and vocational skills training.



Literacy for All - Focuses on 5-8 year olds to help them read much faster in their mother tongue and English. 16 schools in the Helderberg Basin are part of the programme.



Numeracy - A pilot project with 2 Helderberg Basin schools, geared towards improving numeracy using Brombacher books.



Audiology - Donation of a machine to test the hearing of new born babies and infants.



Lwandle Wellness Centre - Provided the funding for renovation of a building which now functions as a place where the local community can come to be tested for HIV/AIDS, TB, blood pressure and much more.



Go for Gold - We are working with Go For Gold, supporting learners to become technically trained professionals in the Construction industry.



Youth - Sponsorship of EarlyAct, Interact and Rotoract Clubs, encouraging youth to be community service minded.



Voice of Rotary - Annual dinner / theatre show, with Cape Town Opera to raise funds to assist up and coming singers with financial support.



Race Night - An annual event of fun with a horse racing theme to raise funds for animal charities.



Vehicle Transfers - Important fund raising activity of moving competitors' vehicles in the Wines2Whales, Houw Hoek and Cape Wineland cycle races.
